Sign up and pay for your exam:

Fall 2019

Join your teacher's course

Use the code provided by your AP teacher to join the course on the College Board site.

Step One

Pay on Total Registration

Go to Total Registration to pay for your exam.

Step Two

Ask for help

Communicate with your AP teacher and AP Coordinator frequently to ensure that registration is complete through Total Registration and the College Board.

Step Three

Changes to the 2019-2020 Test Registration Process

We are currently taking registrations and payments for Fall 2019 courses. Registration and payment options for the Spring 2020 courses will open on January 6, 2020.

College Board:

Student will go to myap.collegeboard.org and use the unique code to "Join a Class." After joining, students will have access to valuable study materials and checkpoints for learning as assigned by the AP teacher for the course. It is important to note that when a student joins the class through the site they are defaulted to "Taking the Exam." August 14

Registration opens on the Total Registration Site

November 8

Registrations and payments after this date will incur a \$40 late fee per exam. This is also the last day to cancel an exam and receive a full refund.

February 28

Registration closes at 9:00 p.m. There will be no refunds after this date.

March 2

Registrations that have not been paid for will be cancelled and exams will not be ordered
